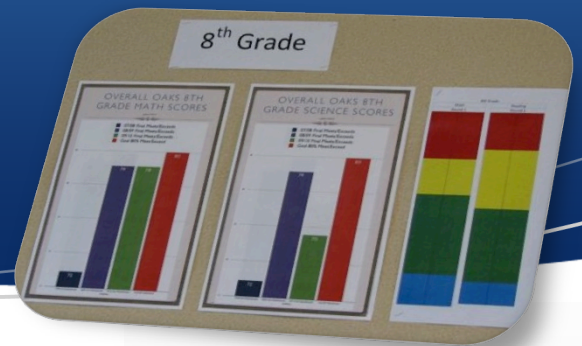

- Get your team ready for Data Teaming with TIPS
- Learn about and apply Meeting Foundations
- Learn how to use one of the recommended meeting minute forms to document decisions and guide the meeting over time
- Define problems and develop hypotheses with precision using a variety of student outcome data from SWIS, EasyCBM and other sources
- Work through solution development; choosing strategies and action planning; formulating results indicators for fidelity of implementation & student outcome measures
